The Library is proud to have as our guest speaker **Sam Mostyn AO**, businesswoman, sustainability advisor, women's advocate in the areas of domestic violence and First Nation women. Sam is the President of Chief Executive Women and chairs the NSW Women's Economic Opportunities Review. Her wide experience encompasses serving on the Global Business and Sustainable Development Commission, the boards of Reconciliation Australia and the Australia Council for the Arts. In 2005 she was the first woman to be appointed to the Australian Football League Commission where she advocated for the inclusion of women at all levels of the AFL.

Between 2013 and 2017 Sam was President of the Australian Council for International Development and Deputy Chair of the Diversity Council of Australia. Sam has held many positions where she has brought to bear her leadership skills and abilities to strengthen civil society. In 2020 she was presented with the United Nations Day Honour award for her significant contribution to advancing the United Nations.
