

The Library is proud to announce Professor Megan Davis as our guest speaker at the 2023 Annual Luncheon at Parliament House. She is currently focussed on rallying Australians behind the Voice referendum and played a critical role in delivering the Uluru Statement of the Heart. Born a Cobble Cobble woman of the Barunggam Nation she is a leading expert in constitutional, Indigenous and public law focusing on advocacy for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. She is pro Vice Chancellor, Society, and holds the Balnaves Chair of Constitutional Law at UNSW. Her work extends internationally through the roles she holds with the United Nations focussing on global Indigenous rights. No doubt her expertise in Aboriginal Constitutional recognition will deepen and enrich our understanding of this important issue.

Jessie Street National Women's Library was established in 1989 to collect and preserve women's literary and cultural heritage. Through the Library's collections, it aims to:

- heighten awareness of women's issues
- preserve material relating to Australian women's lives and experiences
- support the fields of women's history
- highlight the contribution of women to this country's development.

The Library was named in honour of Jessie Street who campaigned throughout her life for women's rights, equal opportunity, social justice for Indigenous people, and world peace. It is staffed by volunteers and is self-funding, relying on membership, donations and fundraising events to cover acquisitions and operating costs.

The Annual Fundraising Luncheon at Parliament House is our main source of income. We hope you and your friends will be able to join us.
